



# Holly Lodge Art 10/11 Curriculum Map 2021

Our GCSE in Art and Design helps students develop knowledge, skills, and understanding to enable them to express their creativity and imagination through responses to visual and written stimuli. The seven specification titles cover the breadth of art and design, both traditional and digital.

From their research and experimentation they will produce a final piece in response to the artwork studied

They will produce work to cover the 4 assessment objectives, Describe, Explore, Record and Present. This work is normally produced in the form a sketchbook.

Year 11 project

Students select from 3 titles and develop research and work under one of these titles focusing on Describe, explore and record.

Produce a final piece from their Pop Art work, showcasing the skills learnt.

Developing the experience of working with a broad range of media and techniques.

Year 10 Pop Art

Students begin with observational drawing of everyday objects. They look at the history of Pop Art and the work of several Pop Artists including Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein
