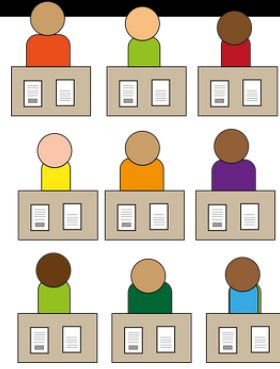
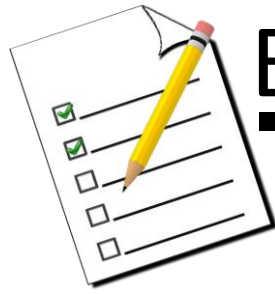

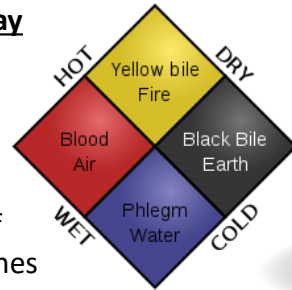
Paper 3: Germany- 1918-39
