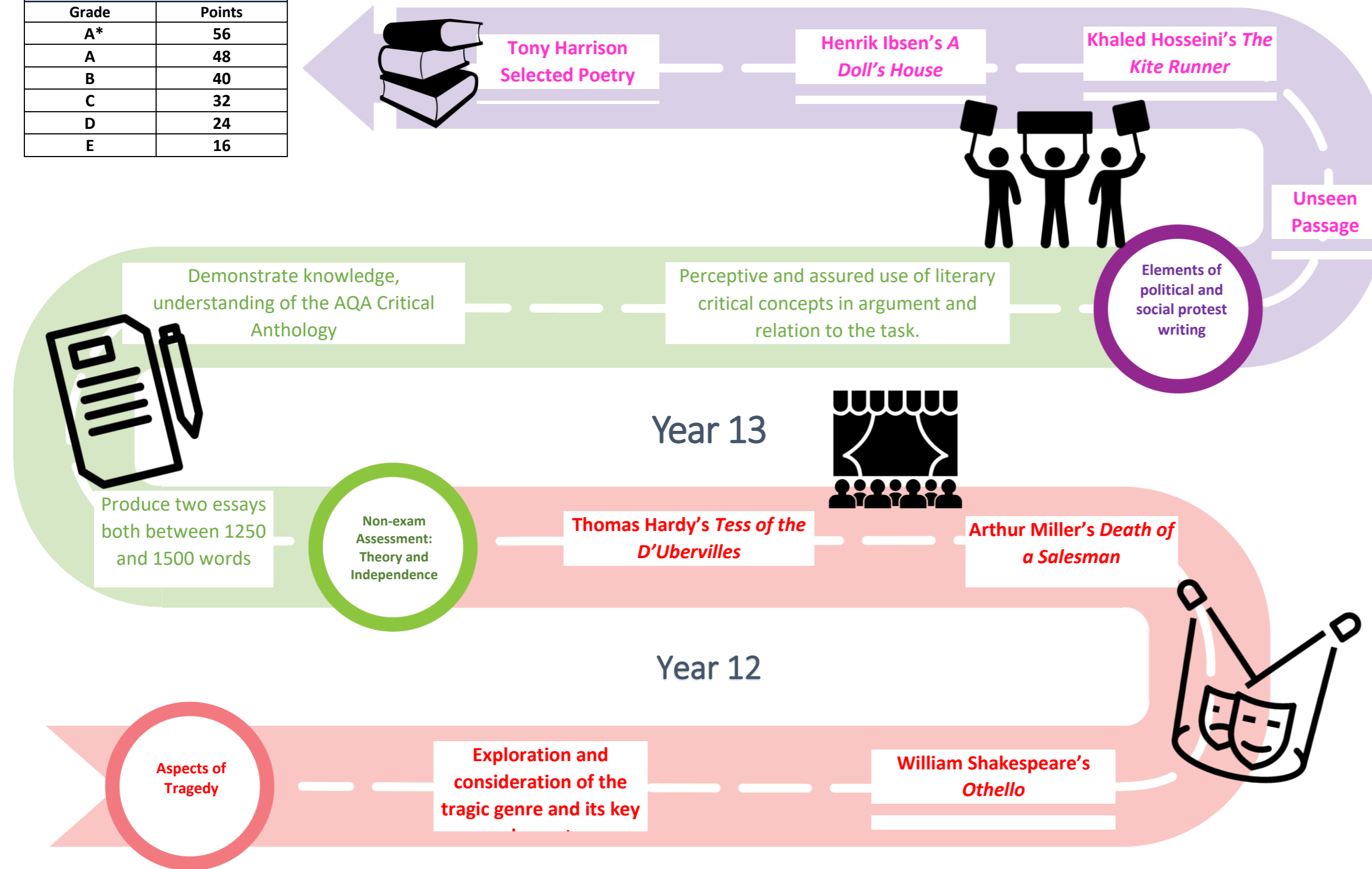




# English Literature A Level 2021-2022
