Schools must ensure that they make it clear to parents. Charges will be made for individual music tuition where it is not part of the syllabus for a prescribed public examination or required by the National Curriculum. Parents may be charged a set fee approved by the Finance Committee of the Governing Body for peripatetic music provision'.

Instrumental Music Lesson Agreement

Between Holly Lodge High School and (pupil's name)

- Holly Lodge High School will provide guaranteed lessons during the academic year. If, due to teacher absence, your child does not receive the correct number of lessons per term and the teacher is unable to 'make up' the lessons during the academic year, then the cost of the missed lessons will be reimbursed.
- 2. Lessons should be paid for in **advance**, a minimum of a half term ahead. Please make payment via the school parentpay system which is accessible from the Holly Lodge website.
- 3. No deduction will be made for pupil absence, or if exams/trips clash with lessons.
- 4. Students are responsible for their attendance to their music lessons. If they know they are going to miss a lesson, then they must see Mrs Ramsay or their instrumental teacher in advance to allow them to rearrange a lesson if possible.
- 5. Parents will need to provide all music and accessories (e.g., reeds, strings, and valve oil)
- Parents must give notice in writing to Mrs Ramsay to terminate lessons. Failure to do so will render the signed liable for the fees for an additional half term. Deadline for terminating lessons is outlined below.
- 7. If your child fails to attend lessons, we will contact you via a text message or a phone call.
