Ways to Prevent Cyberbullying

Notice: Recognize if there has been a change in mood or behaviour and explore what the cause might be.

Talk: Ask questions to learn what is happening, how it started, and who is involved

Report: Most social media platforms and schools have clear policies and reporting processes. If a classmate is cyberbullying, report it the school.

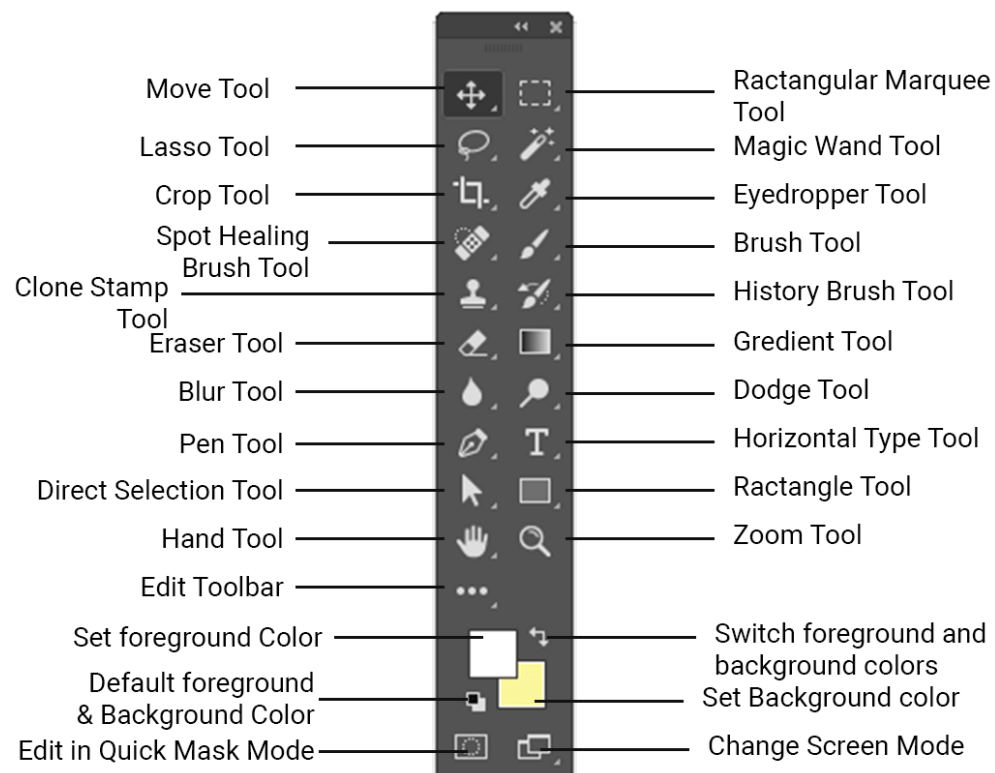
Support: Peers, mentors, and trusted adults can sometimes intervene publicly to positively influence a situation where negative or hurtful content posts about a child

Every time you like a post, search for something online or even share a picture, you leave an online trail - this is called your **digital footprint**. Everything you do online creates information about you which can be used to build a picture of who you are, your likes and dislikes, and this can be really useful for companies and other groups who might want to sell you something or create content for people just like you.

The deliberate positioning of elements within an image.

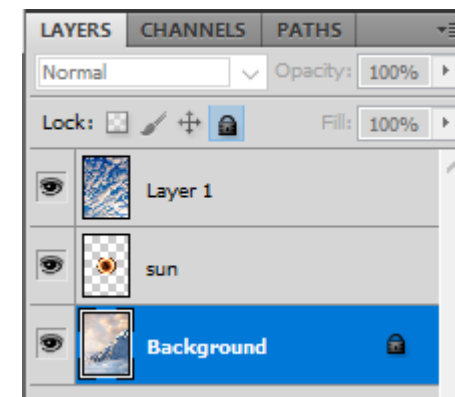
Scalable

Vector Images are able to be changed in size or scale without loss of image quality.

PHOTOSHOP LAYERS

A layer is simply one image stacked on top of another. Changing the order of your layers will change how your picture looks.

Remember to select the correct layer if you are working on an image.



Always name your layers too, don't leave as layer 1.
