GNI Per Capita



Gross national income per person (capita) is the total amount of money earned by a nations people and businesses

HDI



Human development index - The combination of life expectancy GNI and literacy rate (1 is good, 0 is bad)

Sustainable Development Goals



A set of goals set by the United Nations (UN) to improve the global quality of life

Fertility Rate



The average number of children born to each women

Sanitation



Conditions related to public health such as cleanliness (clean water, appropriate sewage system)

Infant Mortality



The number of deaths under the age of 1 per 1000 live births
