Write:

Task 1: Prepare a 5-10 minute verbal presentation on Jury Service. This can be delivered with or without the aid of a computer and needs to contain reference to areas such as:-

- How jurors are chosen
- How jurors may or may not qualify for jury service
- When jurors may be excused from service
- The role of the juror/jury

Task 2: Produce a leaflet for new BTEC in Applied Law 6th Form students that explains the alternatives to the courts in relation to civil dispute resolution. You must discuss:-

- arbitration
- conciliation
- mediation
- negotiation
- ombudsman

Use images as appropriate and give examples of types of cases that would be resolved using the different methods where possible.
