Write:

- Collect materials to make a collage on the theme of 'All about Me'. You can include photos, drawings, and memorabilia and so on to reflect your interests.
- Collect 6 objects that are important to you/represent your identity and that will form the basis of your work. They may be things that recall favourite places, holiday destination, home, your room, a safe haven, etc. Favourite memories, special events or something else- or a combination of many themes, the choice is yours. Use these to draw from, take pictures of, collage etc.
- Think of least six words that reflect who you are; include these in your work
