I'm delighted to share that we were recently awarded 2 grants; firstly for library books worth £3,500! We will use this to buy books which support SEN students and reluctant readers. A huge thank you to Foyle Foundation for this one. The Foyle Foundation was formed to implement the will of the late Christina Foyle. She was the daughter of William Foyle who, with his brother, founded the former family owned bookshop Foyles in Charing Cross Road, London. The second grant is from our community fundraiser in Tesco stores, we are pleased to receive £500 to spend on improving student mental health.

The Performing Arts department will soon be staging our school production of "Moana", on the 11th and 12th of April. The main cast is made up of Y9 and 10

students currently studying GCSE Drama, with a chorus of additional performers from KS3 and 3 local primary schools (Galton Valley, Crocketts Lane & Annie Leonard). We are really excited for these shows, look out for ticket information soon!
