Thank you for your continued support around Attendance and punctuality as we are starting to see improvement in these areas but again it will continue to be a focus for the school, we want to drive up standards for both. The punctuality late detentions have started so if your child arrives after 8.45am then they will receive a 20 minute detention on the same day, pupils who do not attend will be collected the next day to complete the detention.

Attendance is improving, we expect all pupils to have an attendance of 96% or above pupils that are around the 90% mark and below are classed as Persistent absences and we will be making calls, sending letters and doing home visits to pupils we have concerns over. Please ensure if your child is off from school that you let the school know but where possible get the pupils into school as every minute does matter for their learning.

Pupils that have a run of 5 consecutive days off run the risk of a £60 fine for both parents and from September this will double to £120, we will also not authorise holidays in school term time and any medical appointments please ensure holidays and appointments are booked around the school day. Pupils off for 21 consecutive days run the risk of losing their place at Holly Lodge and we will submit to the LA a request to have a pupil taken off roll and they would either need to re-apply or find a new school. These are measures that we don't want to take but we will do so to ensure we improve standards around attendance. 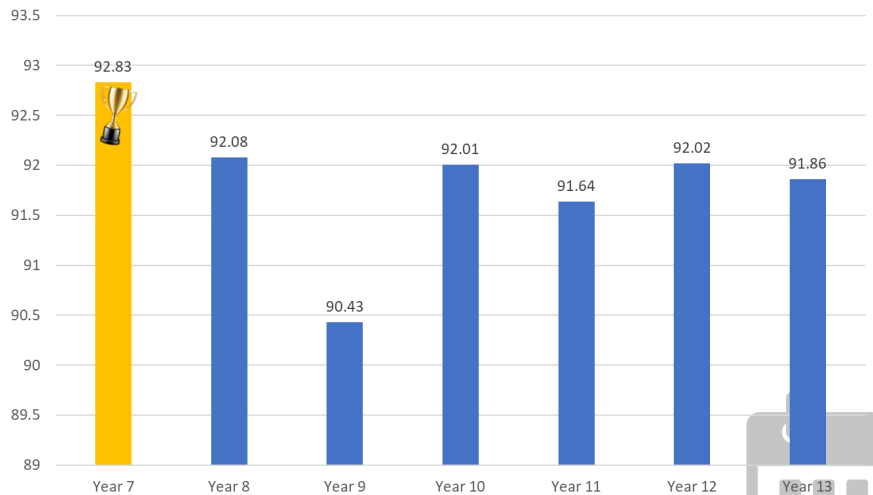
