

This will continue to be a key focus for us this year and we will be working with families to support and reward positive attendance. We will though support families whose child is persistently absent (below 90% attendance) by creating a plan to support them and this may be phone calls home, parental meetings, attendance contracts and submitting of paperwork for potential fines, or removal from roll. Please use the school website for information around attendance and see the posters below, should you have any queries around attendance or punctuality please get in touch with school and ask for Mr Robinson or Mr Burke.

- School day starts at 8.40am pupils should be on site by 8.35am and prepared for the start of form at 8.45am, pupils arriving after 8.47am will be given a 20 minute lunchtime detention on the same day
- When a pupil is off ill families are expected to call the school to provide information, we do encourage pupils to be back in school either later that day or certainly the next day

# ATTENDANCE FINES ARE CHANGING



#### Per Parent, Per Child

Penalty Notice Fines will now be issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. Eg. 3 siblings absent for term time, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines (6 in total).

### 5 Consecutive Days of Term Time Leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for Term Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days. Staff training days are school days and can be included in the 5 or more consecutive days where there was an intent to be absent for term time leave.

#### 10 sessions of unathorised absence in a 10-week period

Fines will be considered when there has been 10 session of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period. Sessions do not need to be consecutive. A session is a morning or afternoon. 10 sessions is equivalent to 5 full days.

#### First Offence

The first time a fine is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

- £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days
- REDUCED to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 day

#### Second Offence (within 3 years)

The second time a fine is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

• £160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days

#### Third Offence and any further offences (within 3 years)


The third time an offence is committed, a Penalty Notice Fine will not be issued, instead the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court. Magistrates' fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on the parents' future DBS certificate, due to 'failure to safeguard a child's education'.
